

Minimum Equipment List

2023 Alberta Provincial Mine Rescue Competition

- Rescue rope sufficient to raise or lower 45 meters
- Rescue rope sufficient to build a belay system for 45 meters
- Sufficient rigging to set up anchors
- Sufficient pulleys to raise or lower a rescue load
- All necessary PPE (CSA approved footwear minimum 6" ankle height).
- Long sleeve shirts or coveralls must be worn
- All teams to have visible numbers being worn
- One stokes litter/basket
- One backboard
- Other equipment deemed necessary to do first aid and rescue for a multi-vehicle/multi casualty accident
- 4 SCBA's and 2 extra bottles
- One multi gas detector
- Bunker gear to fit any of your team members for the fire fighting venue (excluding boots, leather boots are acceptable)
- All leather or fire retardant gloves for fire venue
- Balaclavas for fire venue
- PPE for first aid such as non-latex gloves and barrier devices
- O2 therapy kit (1 complete bottle and full assembly)
- SPO2 Monitor
- Blood Pressure Monitor
- Blood Glucose Monitor

In Addition

1. NOTE: Equipment must have company and team name attached for equipment lock up
2. NOTE: It is not mandatory that masks are blacked/smoked out.
3. NOTE: Direction will be given to members required to fight fire by predetermined selection at the fire event.
4. NOTE: other items of equipment or resources deemed necessary to complete the scenarios will be provided at each separate task
5. **NOTE: All participants will be required to provide a photo ID to write the exam.**
