

Main Event

The Main event typically showcases all aspects of rescue combined into one scenario. This includes but is not limited to rope systems, first aid, fire/search, extrication, and other practical skills based out of the AMSA Mine Rescue Manual.

Points are awarded based on score sheets built by the event head judge and approved by AMSA, The Chief Judge and Assistant Chief Judge.

A head judge will be assigned to the event to be in charge of all judges, patients and score sheets. The head judge will ensure the scenario is run safely and if at any time something unsafe occurs or is about to occur the head judge will stop the scenario.

Live casualties can be used as long as their safety is not at risk. (see other events)

A few reminders for scenario set up:

- The Head Judge must arrive on the Friday before to set up the scenario (suggestion to have one or two people to help out depending on scenario)
- If the rope event is using scaffolding have the main event in the back arena. If the main has scaffolding it will not matter.
- A few things to bring along are: duct tape, rope, tarps, electrical cord
- Ensure all volunteers/ casualties are at the event by 6:30 am so they are all aware of their role for the day and if they have questions you have time to answer them.
